

Subject: Filling up the post of Chairman (Part-time) and Members (Part-time) in Delhi Urban Art Commission (DUAC).

The Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs proposes to appoint suitable persons as Chairman (Part-time) and Members (Part-time) in Delhi Urban Art Commission (DUAC), a statutory body under the Ministry. As per Section 4 of the DUAC Act, 1973, the Commission consists of a Chairman and such number of other members, being not less than two and not more than four as the Central Government may appoint from amongst persons, who, in the opinion of the Central Government, have sensibility and interest in the plastic and visual arts and urban development, or possess special knowledge or practical experience in the field of architecture or art. In terms of the provisions contained in Section 5 of the Act, the Chairman and the Members shall, unless their appointment is terminated earlier by the Central Government, hold office for a term of three years, from the date of their appointment. Further, the Chairman and the Members shall be eligible for re-appointment of that office, but only once.


2. Guidelines prescribed for appointment as Chairman and Member, DUAC are given below:

Fee for attending the meetings of the Commission	As per the DUAC (Terms and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1974 as amended from time to time, the Chairman (Part-time) is entitled to a fee of Rs. 94,700/- per month (fixed).	As per the DUAC (Terms and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1974 as amended from time to time, a Member (Part-time) is entitled to get Rs. 6000/- per day up to a maximum limit of ten

			days in a calendar month for attending the meetings of the Commission.
4.	Age-limit	Below 65 years on the date of appointment.	Below 65 years on the date of appointment.
5.	Educational qualification and experience	Persons having administrative /professional experience in the urban sector, functioning of local bodies, having interest in urban environment, heritage, art, culture, architecture, etc. and having technical/professional expertise or experience in areas of urban planning, architecture urban design, visual arts, etc. may be considered.	Bachelor Degree in Architecture/Town Planning or equivalent from a recognized University/Institute. Minimum 20 years professional experience in the relevant field.
6.	Tenure of appointment	Three years.	Three years.
