<b>Text of RTI First Appeal :</b>	<p>The CPIO has erroneously rejected my RTI application dated 12th April, 2022 on the ground that the information can not be revealed under Section 8(1)(d) and Section 8(1)(e) of RTI Act 2005 due to intellectual property and fiduciary relationship issues respectively. But CPIO has failed to realize that since the building and the complex have already been constructed and the premises have been handed over the ultimate beneficiary. Therefore the Layout Plan no more remains the secret or protected document and hence the same can not be protected from disclosure under Section 8(1)(d) of Section 8(1)(e). Therefore the order dated 11th May, 2022 is erroneous and devoid of law and the urgent appeal is hereby preferred against the impugned order. The Appellate Authority is requested to set aside the order of CPIO dated 11th May 2022 and provide me the information sought vide my RTI application dated 12th April, 2022.</p>
